Annotated Response with Feedback

The pie chart illustrates the proportions of people using different modes of transport in a major city in 2023. The data is categorized into five transport types: private cars, buses, trains or metro, bicycles, and walking.

Feedback: Strong introduction but could be more sophisticated. Consider: "The pie chart delineates the distribution of transport preferences among urban commuters in a major city throughout 2023."

Overall, private cars were the most widely used mode of transport, while walking was the least. Public transportation, including buses and trains, accounted for a significant portion of travel, though private vehicles remained slightly more dominant.

Feedback: Good overview but lacks precision. Replace "significant portion" with exact figures: "collectively represented half of all journeys (50%)". Add more sophisticated vocabulary like "constituted" or "comprised".

Private cars made up the largest share at 35%, followed closely by buses at 30%. These two modes were also a popular choice, used by 20% of people, suggesting that a considerable number of residents relied on public transport.

Feedback: Replace "popular choice" with more precise language: "constituted a substantial proportion" or "accounted for a notable fifth". The phrase "considerable number" is vague - be more specific with data.

By contrast, non-motorized transport options were less common. Bicycles accounted for 10% of total users, while only 5% of people preferred to travel on foot, making it the least favored mode.

Feedback: Good use of contrast. For Band 9, consider: "Conversely, environmentally sustainable transport modes demonstrated markedly lower adoption rates" and "rendering pedestrian travel the most marginal transport preference".

Comparing public and private transport use, the combined share of buses and trains (50%) slightly exceeded that of private cars (35%), indicating a growing dependence on public transit systems.

Feedback: Avoid speculation about "growing dependence" - the data shows only one year. Replace with: "demonstrating that public transport collectively surpassed private vehicle usage by a considerable margin of 15 percentage points".

Grammar and Spelling Corrections

Minor Enhancement: "trains or metro" → **Suggestion:** "rail transport (trains and metro systems)" for more precision

Tense Consistency: All verbs correctly in past tense - well done

Article Usage: Generally accurate throughout

Punctuation: Properly managed - no errors detected

Word Formation: All words correctly formed

Sample Band 9 Response

The pie chart delineates the distribution of transport preferences among urban commuters in a major city throughout 2023, categorizing usage across five distinct modes: private vehicles, buses, rail transport, cycling, and pedestrian travel.

Overall, motorized transport dominated urban mobility patterns, with private cars constituting the single largest segment, while pedestrian movement represented the most marginal preference. Notably, public transport systems collectively surpassed private vehicle usage, indicating substantial reliance on shared transportation infrastructure.

Private automobiles commanded the largest individual share at slightly over one-third (35%), closely followed by bus services at three-tenths (30%). These two predominant modes collectively accounted for nearly two-thirds of all urban journeys. Rail transport, encompassing trains and metro systems, constituted a substantial fifth (20%) of commuter preferences, reinforcing the significance of public transportation networks.

Conversely, environmentally sustainable transport modes demonstrated markedly lower adoption rates. Cycling represented a modest one-tenth (10%) of transport choices, while pedestrian travel constituted merely one-twentieth (5%), rendering it the most marginal transport preference among urban residents.

When aggregated, public transportation modes (buses and rail systems) collectively comprised exactly half (50%) of all journeys, surpassing private vehicle usage by a considerable margin of 15 percentage points, thereby highlighting the critical role of public transit infrastructure in urban mobility.

Weaknesses: Occasional speculation beyond data scope, could be more precise in data presentation.

Improvement: Avoid interpretative language about trends not shown in data, use more sophisticated data presentation techniques.

Coherence & Cohesion (Current: 8 → Target: 9)

Strengths: Logical organization, clear progression, effective paragraphing, good use of cohesive devices.

Weaknesses: Some cohesive devices could be more sophisticated, occasional mechanical linking.

Improvement: Use more varied and sophisticated linking expressions, ensure seamless flow between ideas.

Lexical Resource (Current: 8 → Target: 9)

Strengths: Good range of vocabulary, appropriate word choice, clear meaning throughout.

Weaknesses: Some repetitive expressions, could use more sophisticated academic vocabulary.

Improvement: Incorporate more precise academic terms, use synonyms to avoid repetition, employ more sophisticated collocations.
